Welcome to Castle Rock's Online Options process.

In Year 10, all students will continue to study our core curriculum: English Language and Literature, Mathematics, Science (either Combined Science for 2 qualifications or Triple Science for 3 qualifications), in addition to Physical Education and Religious Education which are non-accredited (no qualification). All students have the opportunity to choose four subjects that they would like to study to the end of Year 11. These subject choices enable students to shape their education towards their future goals.

To make suitable choices, students should think about which subjects are their strengths, what do they enjoy? Students should not think about which member of staff will teach a class or where their friends are.

### Block A

All students must study either History or Geography. Please select your preferred subject of the two. If you wish to take both subjects, choose Geography here and History in block D
