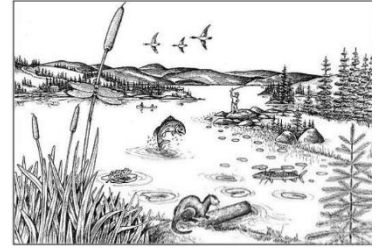

1. Choose one of the following ecosystems found within the UK – Woodland, Moorland, Grassland, Coastal shore line (beach).
2. Research your chosen ecosystem using books, videos, online resources etc. Use at least three resources.
3. Create an A4 poster / power point slide describing your ecosystem covering at least half of the page with text. Include pictures, diagrams and information about the following within your poster:
 - a. General description of your named ecosystem
 - b. Name and describe some of the biotic and abiotic factors found within the ecosystem
 - c. Name some of the pieces of apparatus and instruments that you could use to record quantitative measurements of the abiotic and biotic factors
 - d. Cite (write) your three references onto the poster using the Harvard referencing system as outlined below:

How to Cite a Website in Harvard Format

The basic format to cite a website is:

Author surname(s), initial(s). (Year of publishing) *Title of page/site* [Online]. Available at: URL (Accessed: day month year)
